24/627 To approve the resolution

The Chair opened the discussion to consider the resolution that:

1. There is widespread support among the parishioners of Ockham to consider applying for a S.288 Review of the Inspector's decision in the Public Inquiry concerning Land at Wisley Airfield, Hatch Lane, Ockham, GU23 6NU, under PINS reference APP/Y3615/W/23/3320175;
 2. Richard Harwood OBE, KC has advised on the prospects of success; and
 3. Funds for fees and costs will be available by way of donations.
- And to AGREE that the Council should:
4. Proceed to apply for a Judicial Review;
 5. Appoint Richard Harwood and others to act; and
 6. Appoint solicitors to issue instructions.

Discussion took place on the motion.

24/628 Vote to approve the resolution

Following the debate on the resolution there was a vote with unanimous support of all 5 Councillors in FAVOUR and the Parish Council agreed the Resolution:

1. To proceed to apply for S.288 Review

4. Richard Harwood KC to be retained. Appointment of the Ecology expert, to be approved.
